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Introduction:

This report is a product of a study, administered by Pacific Policy and Research Institute, conducted in Marion and Polk counties. The purpose of this report is to produce questions to assist in the success of the Ten Year Plan to End Homelessness and improve community services throughout these counties for people without a permanent place to live. This report is not an analysis document. It is an exploratory document. Raw data remain virtually unchanged. All primary stakeholders who review this document are encouraged to direct inquiries and/or suggestions to:

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A research team, including more than 50 community members who completed 12 hours of intensive and comprehensive training, collected data from people without a permanent place to live in designated areas throughout Marion and Polk counties. Designated areas included parks, camps, shelters, community service sites, under bridges, streets, and other areas where people without a permanent place to live are most likely to be found. Research team members interviewed 360 individuals who did not have a permanent place to live. The interviews were conducted using an interview schedule designed to be as unobtrusive as possible, and anonymity was afforded to all individuals who voluntarily participated in the interview process. Another designated area was the Marion County Jail where more than 500 prisoners voluntarily participated in a survey that focused on issues related to homelessness. The jail survey component of this study resulted in a participation response rate exceeding 85%. We were not granted access to administer the survey at the Polk County Jail.

The data contained in this report is a result of an extensive examination of data-entry accurateness and represents a reflection of participant responses. The survey instrument and the interview schedule include many quantifiable variables germane to homelessness. The categories of variables include:

- Demographics
- Education
- Employment
- Veteran status
- Residency

- Jail and Prison History
- Substance Abuse
- Mental Health
- Medical Concerns
- Disability Concerns
- Risk of HIV/AIDS and Hepatitis C
- Respondent Perceptions and Recommendations

This report includes a summary of the aforementioned variable categories and 119 pages of statistical tables presented in four sections. It is important for readers to approach this report as a guide for developing questions and points of interest conducive to the continued planning, development, and implementation of the Ten Year Plan to End Homelessness. This report should generate questions and ideas that will advance a comprehensive knowledge base of people without permanent residences in Marion and Polk counties.

Pacific Policy and Research Institute and Homelessness Research:

Pacific Policy and Research Institute (PacPRI) was created to provide comprehensive research, program evaluation, program development, and training for agencies and organizations in many inter-related areas. The mission of PacPRI rests on a platform of Community collaboration and strategy development. Addressing the problems and needs of people without a permanent place to live is an inter-related area that PacPRI considers socially significant with implications to a variety of issues for all members of all communities. The purpose of this study was to create a starting point for addressing homelessness in Marion and Polk counties. The goal of the study was to identify as many people as possible during a one-day count and obtain data that provide a broader insight into the lives of people without a permanent place to live in Marion and Polk counties. These data provide a foundation for community action to address and impact the problem of homelessness at the local level.

Participatory Action Research:

Participatory Action Research (PAR), the hallmark of Pacific Policy and Research Institute, is a "dynamic process that develops from the unique needs, challenges, and learning experiences specific to a given group." PAR is a process whereby people (researchers and participants) develop goals and methods, participate jointly in the gathering and analysis of data, and explore strategies of implementation in ways that elevate consciousness and promote constructive social change.

Participatory Action Research makes use of standard research techniques and provides a methodology for involving a community in the development and assessment of programs set to promote community change. Programs utilizing data generated from PAR share three broad goals:

- To investigate an aspect of reality to transform it
- To develop critical consciousness among all parties concerned
- To improve the lives of all who are involved in the research process

PAR focuses on factors germane to each of these problems, and integrates individuals who are members of populations affected by these problems into the data gathering and analysis process. Second, members and non-members of problem populations become part of the research process as active participants. Integration of member and non-member participants fosters critical consciousness among all parties. Additionally, PAR improves the potential to make positive social change in the lives of all participants. Finally, PAR is consistent with the mission of PacPRI in promoting social justice and individual dignity through socially responsible scientific, comprehensive, and transparent research.

Starting Point:

This research marks the starting point for launching the Ten Year Plan to End Homelessness in Marion and Polk counties. Data collected from this study provide crucial information about the breadth and depth of the problem of homelessness confronting communities in Marion and Polk counties. The purpose of this report is to establish a starting point for the Ten Year Plan, and to develop viable tools for program implementation, and accommodate variable measurement and program evaluation.

Homeless Totals

Totals for the homeless count conducted on January 30, 2007 include one-night shelter counts, count reports from five school district sites, DHS site count surveys, street counts, street surveys, and data collected from the Marion County Jail. The jail counts required the development of two count formulas. The first formula includes only participating prisoners at the Marion County Jail who had no permanent housing before their arrest. The total count using formula 1 is 1,921. The second count formula includes only participating prisoners who have no permanent housing following their release. The total count using formula 2 is 2,006. The total chronic homeless count includes only those individuals who have been without a permanent place to live for more than one year, indicate they have a disability, and are alone. The number of chronic homeless persons identified on January 30, 2007 is 89, which includes 49 identified in the street interviews, 8 in the shelter interviews, and 32 from the one-night shelter counts.¹

Street Count Interviews January 30, 2007

On January 30, 2007, 360 interviews were conducted with people without a permanent place to live in Marion and Polk counties. The interviews were conducted on the street, in parks, under bridges, and in camps. All participants were informed that their names would not be collected, and that their participation was completely voluntary.

Note: The Salem Police Department launched a sweep of homeless people throughout much of the city that resulted in extensive movements of homeless people who were removed from areas where they slept and congregated. The commitment of members of the count teams prevailed, and 360 completed interviews resulted in a rare collection of data crucial to understanding the problems associated with homelessness.

DEMOGRAPHICS:

Street interviews resulted in data collected from 288 males, 67 females, and five individuals described as trans-gender persons. Ages of the respondents were collapsed into four groups (1) Under 21 years of age, (2) 21-35 years of age, (3) 36-50 years of age, and (4) Over 50 years of age. Over 40% of all participants report graduating from high school and/or some college education. Over 27% of the participants are veterans.

HOMELESS CHARACTERISTICS:

100 participants (27.78%) indicate they have been homeless for more than 12 months. Over 70% of all participants indicate they have a place to sleep, and over 64% said they have been in the same location from 1 day to 3 months. Over 68% of the participants say they have stayed in a shelter, and over 52 percent indicated their stay in a shelter lasted 28 days or less. Most participants who have stayed in a shelter lived in a local shelter – just over 5% report staying in a shelter outside of Oregon. Over 85% of participants indicate they eat regularly, although over 87% say they eat 2 times or less per day. Over 28% of the participants indicate their source of money/income comes from part time work, followed by panhandling (25.28%) and scavenging (20.00%). When asked about their plans for tomorrow, over 63% indicated they had no plans or did not know what their plans were, 15.56% said survive, and 20.83% indicated their plans included looking for work. Over 58% of all respondents indicated they were looking for work. More than 84% of the participants said they were alone. When asked about the primary cause of being homeless 23.61% said mental health issues, 22.78% said their jail and prison records, and over 15% said they had no other options. When asked about the most difficult aspect of being homeless 23.89% said dealing with people and 23.61% indicated police harassment (There was a “sweep” of homeless people conducted by Salem Police Department on the day of the count – January 30, 2007). Over 21% said that finding a safe place to sleep was the most difficult part of being homeless. When asked what is necessary to improve their current situation, over 35% said having a place to live, nearly 30% said job or work opportunities, and almost 22% said nothing will ever be done (indicating the prevalence of hopelessness as the third most frequent response).

DISCRIMINATION, VIOLENCE AND HOMELESSNESS:

Participants were asked about discrimination they had experienced due to being homeless, and whether they had ever experienced violence during their homeless status. Over 97% indicated they had experienced discrimination because they were homeless. Almost 62% said they had experienced violence during the time they had

JAIL AND PRISON EXPERIENCE:

Participants were asked about their jail and prison experience. These were not probing questions but rather exploratory questions to determine if the participant had ever been in jail or in prison. Over 74% of the participants said they had been in jail, and 24.17% said they had been in prison.

MEDICAL HEALTH AND DISABILITY VARIABLES:

Participants were asked a series of questions related to health and disability. The purpose for asking these questions was to determine how many participants had health problems, disabilities, how many felt they were at risk for HIV/AIDS and/or Hepatitis C, and when was the last time they saw a doctor. Over 44% indicated they felt they were at risk for HIV/AIDS and/or Hepatitis C. Over 62% said they had medical problems, and more than 54% said they had concerns about disabilities. Nearly 27% had seen a doctor during the past year, over 40% saw a doctor during the past 1-2 years, and more than 16% saw a doctor during the past 3-5 years.

EVICTION AND HOMELESSNESS:

Participants were asked about eviction experiences they may or may not have encountered. This inquiry was extended to examine whether or not eviction resulted in homelessness status, and finally, whether any of those evictions were a result of their inability to pay utility bills. Nearly 56% (201) of the participants experienced eviction from a home. Over 98% (198) of those participants who experienced eviction said that eviction resulted in becoming homelessness. Over 47% (94) of those participants who became homeless because of their eviction said the eviction was due, in part, to their inability to pay their utility bills.

DEMOGRAPHICS:

Ages of the respondents were collapsed into four groups (1) Under 21 years of age, (2) 21-35 years of age, (3) 36-50 years of age, and (4) Over 50 years of age. Over 61% of all participants report graduating from high school and/or some college education. Over 26% of the participants are veterans.

HOMELESS CHARACTERISTICS:

Twelve participants (35.29%) indicate they have been homeless for more than 12 months. Thirty-two (94.12%) said they were currently living in a shelter, and over 40% stated they had lived in the shelter for more than 30 days. Over 61% said they lived in Salem for more than three years. Over 23% said they had been homeless for more than one year before they came to the shelter where they participated in the interview, and nearly 65% said they had previously stayed at other shelters. Over 94% said they are able to eat regularly, and over 76% said they were able to eat three times daily. Over 38% said their source of income was part-time work, followed by 26.47% who received SSI. Fewer than 6% indicated their source of income came from panhandling or scavenging. When asked about their plans for tomorrow, over 44% indicated they would be looking for work, over 29% said they had no plans or did not know what their plans were for tomorrow, and nearly 15% said their plan was to survive. Over 11% said they planned to leave the area. Nearly 59% said they were seeking employment. Nearly 68% said they were in the shelter alone. When asked about the primary cause of being homeless 23.53% said mental health issues, 17.65% said their jail and prison records, and over 23% said they had lost everything. When asked about the most difficult aspect of being homeless 23.53% said dealing with people and 23.53% indicated insecurity the most difficult aspect. Over 17% said that knowing that people do not care and over 17% said not knowing where to sleep were the most difficult aspects of homelessness. When asked what is necessary to improve their current situation, over 55% said having a place to live, nearly 24% said job or work opportunities, and almost 9% said providing healthcare.

Marion County Jail Survey
January 30, 2007

All prisoners at the Marion County Jail had the opportunity to participate in the homeless survey conducted on January 30, 2007, and 508 prisoners completed the survey instrument. Over 40% indicated they did not have a permanent place to live before their arrest, and nearly 57 said they would not have a permanent place to live after their release from jail. Over 48% said they did not have a job prior to their arrest, and more than 75% said they would not have a job to go to following their release from jail. Nearly one-half of the prisoners (48.23%) said they did not have adequate hygiene supplies and basic clothing upon their release from jail.
