Energy Conservation

Tips:

- ◆ Set winter heating temperatures to 68 degrees.
- ◆ Set summer cooling temperature to 78 degrees.
- ◆ Use LED Light bulbs to save up to 80% on lighting cost compared to incandescent lights.
- ◆ Refrigerators should be kept between 36-40 degrees.
- ◆ Freezers should be kept between 0-5 degrees.
- ◆ Electronics that are turned off may continue to use power. Unplug convenient electronics and plug others into a power strip.

Do you need Weatherization?

Weatherization can drastically reduce electric and gas bills. If your home is drafty, musty or too cold during the winter you could likely benefit from weatherization.

Description of possible weatherization services:

Energy Audit: This is an assessment that will be performed to determine the weatherization needs of your home.

Insulation: Depending on existing R-values and accessibility, insulation may be added to attics, floors, walls and duct systems to improve overall energy efficiency of your home.

Air sealing: Minimizes excessive drafts by caulking interior molding/trim, sealing around plumbing/drain pipes protruding through floors/walls and weather-strip doors.

Ventilation: Adding proper ventilation can help create a healthier living environment and reduce moisture levels in a home. Furnaces with ducts and all gas appliances need proper ventilation in a home to work most efficiently.

Steps of the MWVCAA Weatherization Program:

1) Call MWVCAA Weatherization at 503-315-7055 to be placed on a waitlist for services.

2) When your name comes to the top of the waiting list you will be called for an intake interview where your household information will be verified per program qualifications.

3) You will receive weatherization education and an energy saving kit.

4) An energy audit will be performed. This will include an assessment of the efficiency of your home.

5) The weatherization work will occur. Licensed contractors may install insulation, reduce air leaks and perform other energy saving measures.

6) A final inspection will be performed to insure the compliance with policies, quality of craftsmanship and safety of all weatherization measures.

How to qualify for weatherization:

•Be a Marion or Polk county resident who owns or rents.

•Provide supporting documentation of household member identification and utility company.

•Provide proof of income within these guidelines:
