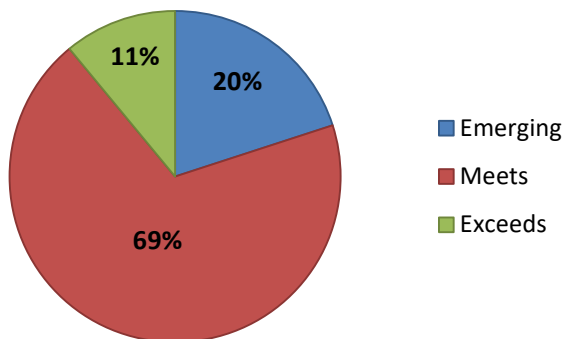


Community Action Head Start Winter Pre K Child Outcomes 2016-2017

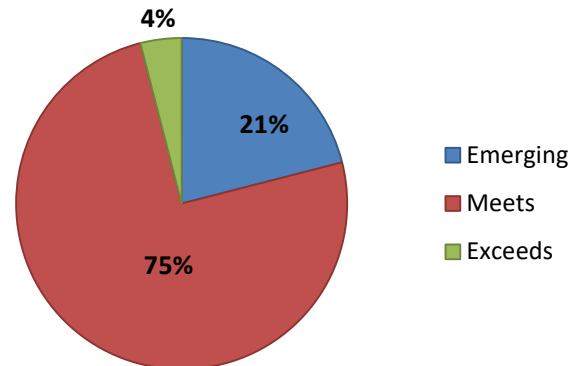
The Winter outcome illustrates children's progress at the mid-point in our school year. While the majority of children are meeting expectations across all areas of development, we recognize that roughly 20% of our children are emerging in all areas. Math continues to be an area of concern. While we can typically expect significant growth in math between our winter and spring checkpoint, the consistency of this area being one of the last to show progress, challenges our program to provide increased opportunities for children to find math in every day experiences starting at the beginning of the school year. Language can be another potentially challenging area as we strive to ensure that all children have the opportunity to receive instruction and be assessed in their home language. Both language and literacy are strengths in our program but the results are not fully seen until the spring outcome.

We are pleased with the progress our children are making and confident in the experience and skills of our teachers as they observe and accurately assess children.

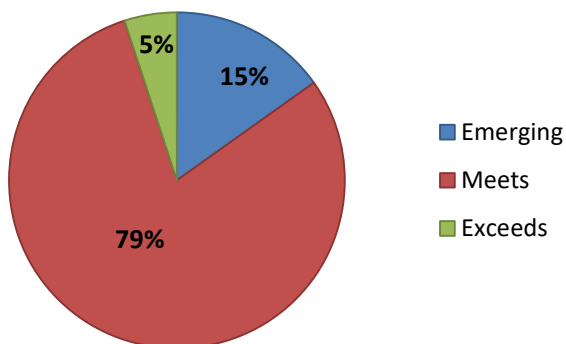

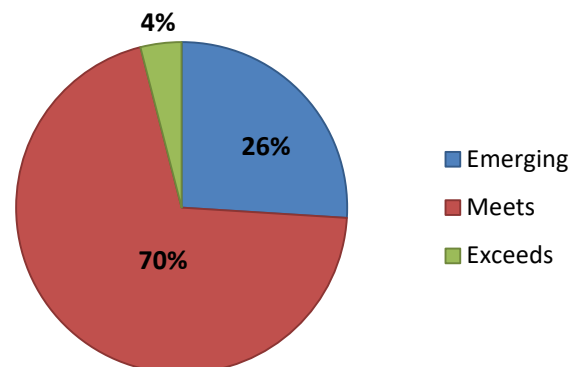
Physical - Gross Motor



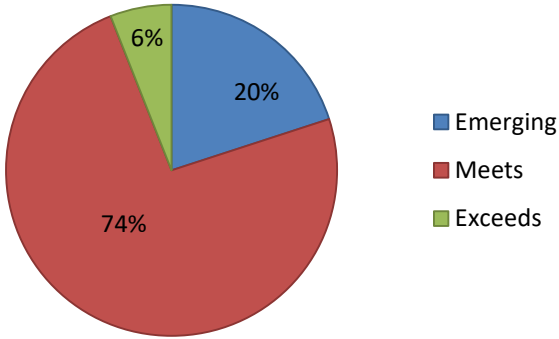
Physical - Fine Motor



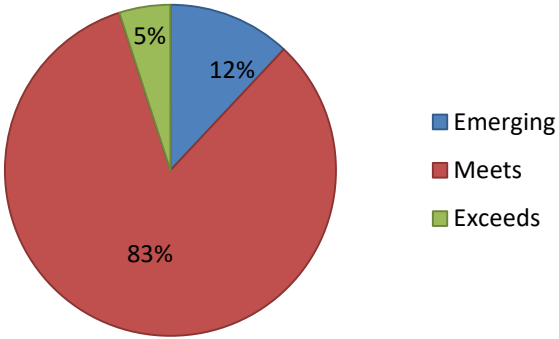
