**Community Action Early Head Start and Family Building Blocks are accepting applications for the 2024–2025 school year.**

**Serving infants and toddlers up to age three years and expectant mothers from Marion and Polk Counties.**

**Early Head Start Services are available in these variations:**

- Home Base (weekly home visits & twice a month family play groups).
- Marion County Locally Designed Options (2 days in class per week & 2 home visits a month) with bus transportation whenever possible.
- Polk County Locally Designed Options.

**What is Early Head Start?**

Early Head start is a program designed to assist expectant mothers & families with young children in all developmental areas including: nutrition health, family services, mental health, education & healthy parent-child relationships. Once accepted into the program, the children is guaranteed continuing placement until they reach pre-school or age out.

**What are the eligibility requirements?**

Homeless families, foster families, families currently receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) or Supplemental Social Security Income (SSI) or families who meet federal poverty income guidelines are eligible to apply. No proof of citizenship is required.

Program is meeting all COVID health/safety guidelines for in-person services.
