

#### Early Head Start CCP services are available in several variations:

- Full Day/Full Year: full-time care for children age 6 weeks to 3 years of working families in a Registered/Certified Child Care Home who are under a contract with Community Action to provide Early Head Start Services.
- Teen Parents in the Salem Keizer Teen Parent program with children age 6 weeks to 3 years
- Pregnant Teens attending Salem Keizer Teen Parent Program

# What is Early Head Start Child Care Partnerships?

- A program designed to assist expectant teen mothers and low-income families with young children.
- Includes all developmental areas: nutrition, health, family services, mental health, education, and healthy parentchild relationships.
- Located in Registered/Certified Child Care Homes or participating Teen Parent Programs.

### What are the eligibility requirements?

- Parent (s) must be working at least 25 hours per week during daytime hours Mon-Fri.
- Must be receiving or willing to apply for ERDC.
- Homeless families, foster families, and families who meet federal poverty income guidelines.
- Teens enrolled in participating school districts teen parent programs.
- No proof of legal status is required.

Program is meeting all COVID health/safety guidelines for in-person services.
