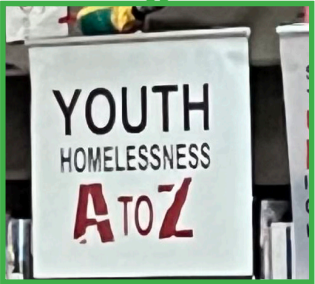
1994

HOME begins as a grass roots organization led by homeless youth and adult mentors. In 2003, HOME joined MWVCAA. HOME now has 24/7 365 services for youth in the area including housing and sheltering opportunities, Drop In space, paid job training, outreach, and case management.

2017



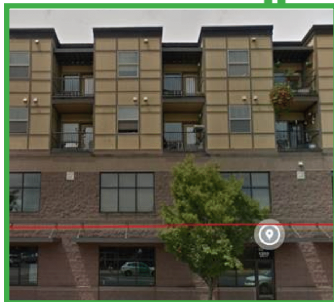
Taylor's House opened as the only emergency shelter for minors between Eugene and Portland. The shelter continues to operate as a 10 bed emergency shelter in partnership with Oregon Department of Human Services.



2022

HOME worked with local Youth Action Board (Backbone) to develop additional housing opportunities for youth and young adults through the Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP).

2023



The Drop In moved to 1255 Broadway St. to improve service capability and offer a more efficient, accessible operational space for youth; HOME opened transitional housing in Monmouth; and HOME service capacity increased to include youth and young adults up to age 24 through different projects.

# Housing

## Emergency Shelter

24/7/365 short-term shelters where youth can temporarily stay while they work toward reunification and self-sufficiency. Staff works closely with youth and their community to set goals and achieve them.

## Transitional Housing

Transitional services for youth ages 14-18. Case management, life skills training, education, and youth led goals are established to encourage the success of every youth.

## Rapid Re-Housing

Resource navigation, case management and rent assistance for young adults ages 16-24.
