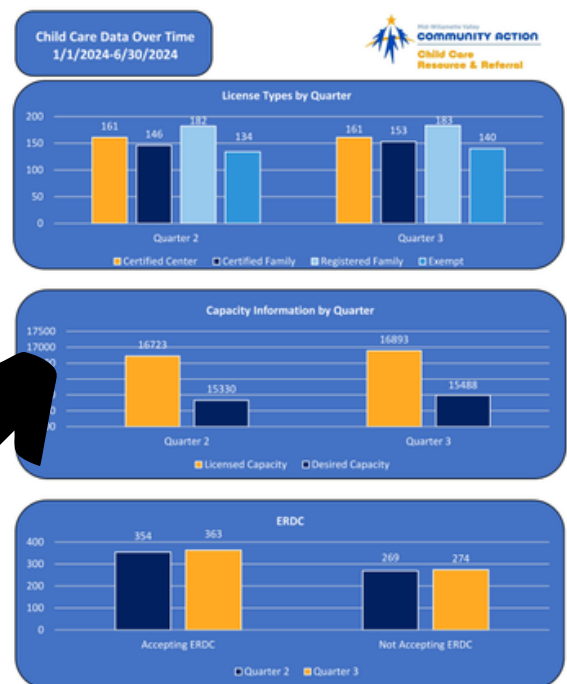

The Importance of Schedules and Routines

Just like adults, children feel more confident and secure when their daily activities are predictable and familiar. A consistent daily schedule and step-by-step routines give children a predictable day. Schedules and routines in the group care setting and at home help children:

- Feel in control of their environment
- Feel safe, secure, and comfortable
- Know what is happening now and what comes next
- Know how to do an activity or task
- Engage in learning



What is the difference between a schedule and a routine?

- A schedule represents the big picture and includes main activities that happen across the day.
- Routines are the steps needed to complete each part of the schedule.

Did you know....



That all children are entitled to equal rights in childcare?

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) is a federal civil rights law stating that people with disabilities are entitled to equal rights in employment, public services, and access to places of public accommodation. Public accommodations include childcare in homes, centers, after school programs, and everywhere childcare is provided.

The ADA clearly states that **providers cannot refuse to enroll a child with a disability** and that “reasonable accommodation” must be made to serve them. A reasonable accommodation is any adaptation or alteration of strategies to better serve all children.



Since inclusive practices support children regardless of age or ability, imbedding inclusive strategies in your daily routines, your ways of communication, and your curriculum is a win-win! **Inclusive Partners (IP) can help you at no cost!** IP can provide individual consultations, talk through inclusive practices that work in your childcare setting, free staff trainings, and more. 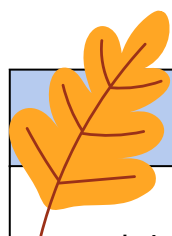

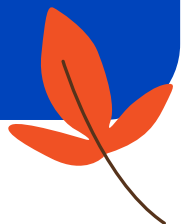

To become licensed through the **Child Care Licensing Division (CCLD)**, you will need to attend at no charge, **two-part Introduction to Registered Family Child Care (IRFCC)** and additional health and safety classes.
