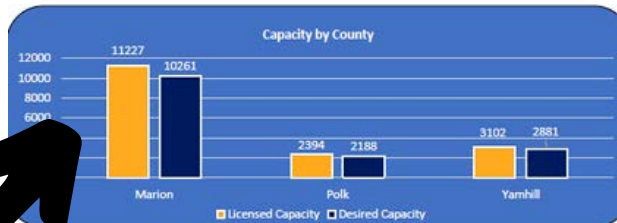

Stages Of Block Play



Children go through various stages of block play.

As they work through the learning of one stage they are ready to move on to the next stage of play. As skills advance, it is typical for children to combine several stages. The stages are developmental—each one building on the last—but children advance at their own rate regardless of their age.

- Stage 1: Discovering Blocks
- Stage 2: Stacking Blocks
- Stage 3: Complex Stacking and Bridges
- Stage 4: Making Enclosures
- Stage 5: Creating Bridges or Arches
- Stage 6: Combining Enclosures and Bridges
- Stage 7: Patterns and Symmetry
- Stage 8: Block Structures that Represent Objects for Pretend Play



Classroom Environment Ideas

Block Area Materials:

- My House blocks
- Rulers for measurement
- Clipboards and crayons
- "Look what I did binder" with pictures of their buildings
- Books related to theme/building
- Vocabulary words for teachers!
- Images of theme related buildings



What's Happening with Star Ratings? As of October 1st, 2023

For programs new to Spark:

- To submit a portfolio and receive a star rating, programs must be listed with ERDC.
- Programs that are not ERDC listed or do not wish to complete a portfolio can choose to complete an optional 12-month QI cycle.
- The QI Cycle will not lead to a star rating but they will receive a monetary award after completion (amount to be determined).



For programs already in Spark:

- If a program has achieved a star rating, it will not be taken away if it is not listed with ERDC.
- If a program has not yet submitted a portfolio or wants to apply for a higher rating, ERDC listing is required.
- If a program's rating is expired, they can complete a Spark Program Update Report (SPUR) to receive an updated certificate and information on completing a rating renewal. \$200 will be awarded after the completion of a rating renewal.
- Programs also have the option to complete a 12-month QI cycle. They will receive a monetary award after completion (amount to be determined).

To become licensed through the **Child Care Licensing Division (CCLD)**, you will need to attend at no charge, **two-part Introduction to Registered Family Child Care (IRFCC)** and additional health and safety classes.

To become listed through ERDC, you will need to attend a free, **two part ERDC Child Care Provider Orientation**.

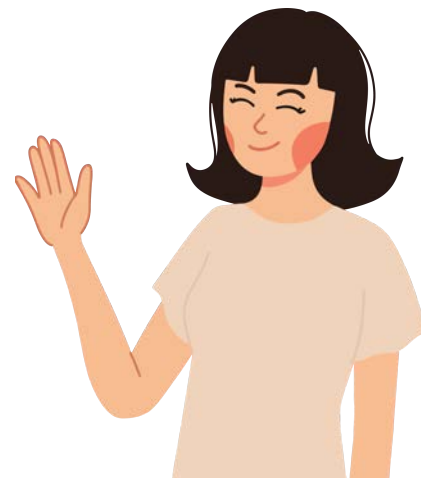
